

# Freedom Swim Team Code of Conduct

The Freedom Dolphin Swim Team expects all participants – Swimmers, Coaches, Parents to demonstrate good sportsmanship. Everyone involved in the program must agree to act in accordance with this philosophy.

**Respect** – Treat the coaches, parents, and other swimmers with respect. Be especially respectful of officials, stroke and turn judges and other swimmers. Respect the authority and decisions of the judges.

**Learning** – Swimmers are expected to try their very best and not disrupt others at practice.

**Support** – Swimmers and Parents are expected to encourage good sportsmanship and support the team by cheering and giving positive comments.

**Participation** – By learning how the meets run, being on time for meets, following the rules of the pool and the swim team. Signing up to help at meets and other swim team events.

The Freedom Swim team is prepared to discipline those who demonstrate unacceptable behavior. The following actions will be done.

1<sup>st</sup> offense – Verbal warning.

2<sup>nd</sup> offense – Verbal warning and parent's contacted.

3<sup>rd</sup> offense – Removal from practice and parent's contacted.

4<sup>th</sup> offense - Removal from next meet.

5<sup>th</sup> offense – Removal from the team
